To All Parents, Guardians and Volunteers of EBYFC,

Distressingly, it has been brought to the attention of the Board of Directors of the Association of Eastlake/Bonita Youth Football and Cheer that there has been considerable unsportsmanlike, non-supportive and simply plain rude, behavior taking place at some practice fields/venues of the Cheer and Football teams.

This will not be tolerated by the Board of Directors, especially if it adversely affects the participation of any child within this Association, as it appears to have happened on a couple of occasions this week within the Cheer program.

Please be reminded that you all signed a Parent's Code of Conduct when you signed up your child to participate. Some of the salient points of this document follow –

- I/we hereby pledge to provide positive support, care and encouragement for my child participating in youth sports by following this Parent's Code of Conduct.
- I/we will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, cheerleaders, coaches and officials at every game, practice or other youth sports event.
- I/we will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- I/we agree to follow the proper chain of command when filing a complaint or voicing my opinion regarding any possible rule infraction or concern within the SDYFC/EBYFC.

Each of these has been disregarded over the past few weeks by far too many of our parents, guardians and volunteers, causing some of our children to quit. This is simply not acceptable to the Board. We will not have a few people tainting the good name of EBYFC within the community, nor affecting the ability of all within our community to participate.

Please be advised that if you disregard any part of the Parent's Code of Conduct you will be asked to leave the Association, as will your child.
